## **BBY Summer Camp 2011**

The Big back yard summer camp is a specifically designed to meet the needs of 3 -7 year olds. Each week has a theme that allows children to create and use their imaginations throughout the day. The program runs from 9:00 -2:30 daily. The cost per week is \$175.00\* plus a \$5 per child per week snack fee.

Our camp is staffed by licensed certified teachers and junior counselors who have been carefully selected because of their love to work with and play with young children.

9:00 Morning meet and greet

9:30 Announcements, circle games and silly songs

10:00 Activities period based on the weekly theme

2:15 PM snack provided by camp (all natural fruit popsicles)

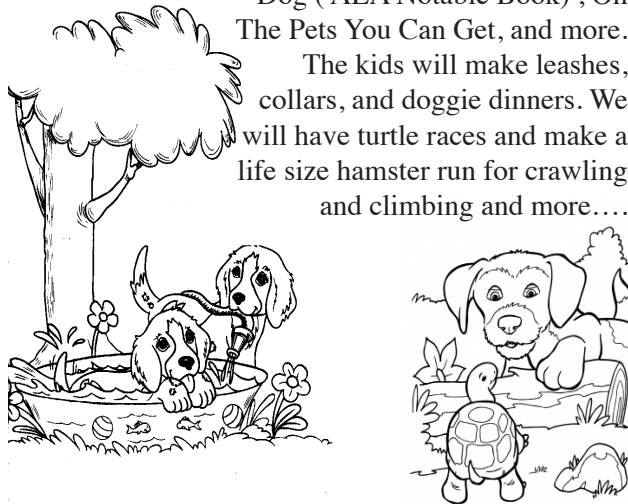
2:30 Wrap up and goodbyes

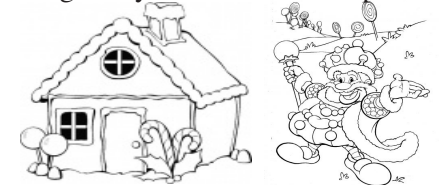

This week we will make tons of pretend sweet confections. For a morning snack treat we will have a make your own fruit smoothies . We will also make homemade ice cream the old fashion way. We will create a working confections shop with candy made from clay, play-dough, pipe cleaners and other materials. The kids will get an opportunity to sell their sweet creations to each other, the the teachers and parents at pick up. No worries we will also make money and tickets should you stop at the shop. Our young sales people will make special hats and costumes to wear when working at the shop. In additwion we will create a life size candy land game where the children pick a card and then either move ahead on the board, skip to a land of treats or go back to start. They will make an environment for their creatures, figure out what it eats and any special care that animal will need. We will talk about how the animal communicates.
